

Case Study:

Flash to HTML5 Migration



Multiple course-conversions for a business conglomerate.

Client Description: The client is a business conglomerate holding company which owns businesses across energy, petrochemicals, textiles, natural resources, retail, and telecommunications.

Business Need: The organization had a repository of more than 100 hours of Flash-based courses owned by its Learning Academies. These courses were integral to their L&D framework. With uncertainty over the support of Flash by Adobe and its compatibility with common browsers in the long run, the client wanted to plan for the longevity of these courses. In the process, they also wanted to update some content and also make the course compatible with their LMS application.

Solution: MPS Interactive migrated these Flash-based courses into mobile-responsive HTML5 for the various learning academies of our client. It utilized the capabilities of our LearnX mobile tool for the migration. The client also requested content updates for some of the courses that MPSi would need to implement along with the migration process. We used the combination of HTML5, CSS3, JavaScript, and JQuery to migration. The courses are compliant to SCORM 2004 specifications. They are hosted on our client’s Opigno LMS and can also be accessed using the Opigno app.
